Subject: Field Note Jack Peters Gulch Creek, Mendocino County

On June 14, 1987, Alan Grass, Fish Habitat Assistant, walked Jack Peters Creek from the Pacific Ocean to the Surfwood Subdivision Dam. The purpose of the survey was to determine the passability for adult anadromous fish of an eight-foot bedrock falls located approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile downstream of the dam.

The "falls" were judged to be a barrier to adult steelhead at nearly all flows.

Some juvenile salmonids were observed at several sites and one partial barrier log jam was recorded approximately 100 yards below the falls.
